Road 13 Vineyards is family owned and operated by Pam and Mick Luckhurst, who purchased the winery in December 2003. The winery is located between Osoyoos and Oliver, at Highway 97 and Road 13 on the Okanagan Valley's historic "Golden Mile." The winery has a short but colourful past and continually receives ongoing critical acclaim for making wines that many feel are a quintessential expression of Okanagan Valley terroir. The Luckhursts then discovered Okanagan-born and raised winemaker Michael Bartier, and the three hit it off immediately. Michael joined the Road 13 team in 2004 and his first wines were released from the 2005 harvest. "It's All About The Dirt" reflects our belief that great wines start in the vineyard. We respect our vineyards and work hard to farm with integrity.

Road 13's wines are presented in three distinct tiers:

**Honest John's Red and White** - Road 13's blended red and white wines are a tribute to "Honest" John Oliver, BC Premier from 1918-1927. His greatest achievement was the construction of the irrigation canal that transformed the Golden Mile into outstanding farmland.

**Road 13 Varietal Series** - The varietal series express the special character of the South Okanagan's renowned Golden Mile. Our motto, "It's All About The Dirt", reflects our belief that great wines start in the vineyard.

**The Jackpot Line** - Southern BC is a home to hundreds of old gold mines with names that acknowledge the region's past exploration. One, called Jackpot, inspired us. Evoking the joy of winning a hard-earned prize, it is a fitting title for our top wines - the reward for our hard work in the vineyard and cellar.

Recent vintages made by Emmanuel Reynaud, Jaques' nephew, are developing well and suggest that the domaine has as bright a future as it's past.

Bought by one of Jean Paul Daumen's ancestors in 1905, the estate of Vieille Julienne sold wine in bulk to the trade, with the first bottling of each vintage being reserved for family and friends. Wine production at that time was focused on the vines and to this day; much of the harvest still comes from 100 year plus vines. Commercial bottling began toward the end of the 60's, when Maxime Daumen renovated the cellar and bought new "foudres". From year to year and father to son, the estate prospered. It was in 1990 that Jean Paul Daumen joined the domaine.

### Châteauneuf du Pape

The village of Châteauneuf du Pape is built on a hillside, dominating the Rhône valley, the Venaissin Comtat (the territory for centuries under papal control, now known for its acres and acres of vineyards). Narrow lanes and flag-stone paved stairways lead up to the vestiges of the castle, atop the hill. A landmark date for the region is 1936, the year the winemakers requested and received the appellation of controlled origin (AOC) Châteauneuf du Pape. The strict rules of the AOC governs the wine production from the vineyard to the bottle, permitting the 205 vineyards within the territorial designation of Châteauneuf du Pape to produce wines of exception. The embossed escutcheon of the papal tiara and the keys of Saint-Peter surrounding the inscription "Châteauneuf du Pape controlled" is now recognized worldwide.
